September 11, 2023

The regular meeting of the Lyons Village Council called to order on September 11, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor: Andrea Gleckler, Council members: AJ Call, Nelson Barnhiser, John Good, Julie Fenicle, Mark Bryson; Village Administrator, Tanya Lumbrezer.

**Employee/Administrative/ Committee Reports**

- \*Dollar General – things are moving forward projected start date in the spring, subject to change
- \*N Adrian St – still hope to have started by end of the year. The contractor was in a bad accident so things are a little delayed.
- \*Dump truck – hopefully will be in soon, there were some issues with the doors opening that need fixed
- \*Mower – is back in to get fixed, should be back this week
- \*Radar signs – moved 2 from 25mph east/west to 35mph north/south seems to be helping
- \*Farmers Market – next farmers market is Sept 9<sup>th</sup> from 5-9. 14 registered vendors
- \*CT – got all paperwork for OPWC grant/loan submitted
- \*New money market account is officially setup and the funds have been transferred to the premium account
- \*We are confirmed with T&R for leaf pickup.. dates to TBD
- \*sent Jacob Barnes copies of our zoning books and he is going to help guide us
- \*THM's – look good - tower 33.3, pumphouse 59.3
- \*62 houses chose one of Atlas's trash programs, everyone else is using tags
- \*AJ is looking into a PA system for the parades
- \*Electric Aggregate for 2024-2026 will be Dynegy at a rate of .0655/kwh opt out letters will go out in October
- \*Fall letters were sent out 9/6/23
- \*Lyons Boosters gave a \$2,500 donation to the park from the BBQ
- \*August 2023 usage 1,986,000 gallons

- \*AJ Call motioned to approve Resolution 23-14 for the water/sewer assessment for Rory Figley in the amount of \$773.90, Nelson Barnhiser seconded, 5 in favor, 0 opposed
