

**VILLAGE OF LYONS  
COUNCIL MEETING  
AUGUST 7, 2017 7:00 P.M.**

The regular meeting of the Lyons Village Council was called to order on Monday, August 7, 2017 at 7:00 pm. Present Mayor Andrea Gleckler, Council members Neil Shaw, John O'Neil, John Good, Julie Fenicle, Mark Bryson, Village employee Ron Ankney, Village Administrator Tanya Lumbrezer and Fiscal Officer Luann O'Hara. The meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made and seconded to accept the minutes from the July 10, 2017 meeting. 5 yea, motion passed.

A motion was made and seconded to accept Financial Report from July 2017. 5 yea, motion passed.

A motion was made and seconded to accept the Bills from July 2017. 5 yea, motion passed.

Melissa Hudik was present to observe because she has a possible interested in joining Council.

**Employees Report**

Ron Ankney reported water usage for July was 3,038,000 gallons. Ron reported Sunny's usage was 500,000 gallons for the month with 126,000 gallons used on their highest day. John O'Neil asked where the lagoon is in reference to discharging. Ron stated the lagoon is at 4 ½ feet and at 5 feet discharge is needed. Ron stated the lagoon is 1,000,000 gallons per foot so will be a while before discharge. Ron informed Council the water tower pump was changed for \$1500 and that Ed Spregg from Fremont changed the pumps. Ron stated the air filter was also changed and he showed the old pump to Council and how plugged it was. Ron asked Tanya to check with original installers about the warranty and a refund on the air filter. Ron stated that a full body harness is needed to climb the water tower. Ron informed Council he would like to put a chlorine analyzer at the pump house for \$4500.00. Ron stated the analyzer will help with THM testing. Discussion. A motion was made and seconded to purchase a chlorine analyzer for \$4500. 5 yea, motion passed.

**Old Business**

Tanya reported she sent 18 ten day notices, 1 one day notice and two are still shut off. John O'Neil asked if residents are still getting water bills late. Tanya stated the water bills were received late again and Russ at the Post Office is writing a letter to his superiors to inform them of the problems. Tanya stated she talked to USTI and they are checking on E Billing.

Tanya informed Council the water loss for June was 22%. John Good asked if Rod could put a sticker of some kind on the hydrants to see which hydrants are being opened. Tanya stated she would talk to Rod and that there has been no activity on the camera at the Fire Hall.

Tanya reported she talked to Gary Keyes from Toledo Edison and to replace the street lights

with LED lights the cost is \$344 per pole with a minimum purchase of twelve lights. Tanya stated the Village has 69 street lights. Tanya stated that Toledo Edison will fix and replace all lights. Discussion. A motion was made and seconded to purchase street twelve LED street lights at \$344 per light in the downtown area. 5 yea, motion passed.

John O'Neil asked if there was any reply on the security cameras for the downtown area. Tanya replied she hasn't received an answer.

John Good asked if the speed camera is going to return to town. Tanya stated the speed camera is coming back.

Tanya informed Council their petitions for the Nov. Election are due Aug. 9, 2017 to the Board of Elections. Tanya stated she will remind AJ.

Tanya informed Council Pastorek's did a nice job fixing the rust on the pickup for \$675.

Tanya reported the grass has been cut at the Perdue property and that Mae Perdue is living on North Adrian Street again. Tanya stated that Marge Shuman is close to selling that property.

### **Administrator's Report**

Tanya informed Council the FCEDC membership is up for renewal at \$500. Tanya stated she thinks it is worth the money. Discussion. A motion was made and seconded to renew the FCEDC membership for \$500. 5 yea, motion passed.

Tanya informed Council the Trot for Track wants to move back to Lyons this fall. Tanya stated that Phil Schwan is heading it up. Tanya stated the event is Sept. 17, 2017 and the ball park is not booked so she gave him the go ahead.

Tanya informed Council the September meeting is supposed to be on September 4, 2017 which is a holiday and asked when Council wants to have the meeting. Discussion. Council decided to have the meeting on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 at 7:00pm.

Tanya reported the BBQ was slow and they did not have as many teams as last year.

Tanya reported a donation of \$50 was sent to the Disabled Vets in memory of Mel O'Hara's brother passing.

John Good stated he received a refund check from RITA for 2016 and he would like Tanya to call RITA because he wants interest from RITA for the late payment.

### **Mayor's Report**

Mayor Gleckler reported she and Tanya attended the TMACCOG Meeting. Mayor Gleckler stated there several villages from Fulton County there. Mayor Gleckler stated the meeting was very interesting and she is planning to attend the next meeting. Mayor Gleckler stated they discussed Lake Erie algae blooms, Schools, EMA Coordinator and several other interesting topics.

Mayor Gleckler stated she received another neighbor dispute complaint. Mayor Gleckler stated she told the residents to call the Sheriff's Dept. and there is nothing Council can do.

Mayor Gleckler informed Council she received a letter from Sheriff Roy Miller thanking the Village for support and cooperation with both the security cameras and the speed sign.

John O'Neil stated his concern about Village residents not being notified about the Sheriff shooting and the suspect at large. Mayor Gleckler stated it is her mission to get with Sheriff

Miller to see what the Village can do in these situations.


Mayor Gleckler stated she saw Mel O'Hara and he is very happy with his new job.
