

VILLAGE OF LYONS

COUNCIL MEETING

JUNE 3, 2019 7:00 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Lyons Village Council called to order on Monday, June 3, 2019 at 7:00 pm. Present: Mayor, Andrea Gleckler; Council members: A.J. Call, Neil Shaw, John Good, Julie Fenicle, Mark Bryson and Jimmy Thornton; Village Employee Ron Anckney; Village Administrator, Tanya Lumbrezer and Clerk/Fiscal Officer, Pam Kurfiss. The meeting opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion made by Neil Shaw and seconded by John Good to accept the minutes from the May, 2019 meeting. 6 yea, motion passed.

A motion made by Julie Fenicle and seconded by John Good to accept Financial Reports from May, 2019. 6 yea, motion passed.

A motion made by John Good and seconded by AJ Call to accept the reading of the bills from May, 2019. 6 yea, motion passed.

Public

Sgt. Hayward of Fulton County Sheriff's Dept. was present and gave a report of the April/May calls that they had in the village. There were 26 calls since 3/6/19. Discussion was held regarding the speeding of traffic in the village and Sgt. Hayward said that they could possibly spend some time in the Lyons/Metamora area in August to monitor the situation.

Employee's Report

Ron Anckney stated that the TTHM numbers were good. He also handed out a TTHM Stage 2 report (attached) of results and averages since 2013 to now. Discussion held. He also passed out an information sheet (attached) regarding the Village of Lyons water rates for in town residents (\$22.00/2000 gal.), outside of town residents (\$31.00/2000 gal.) and for surplus water (\$14.00/2,000 gal.). The cheapest water is the surplus water and in his opinion, surplus water should be more than \$7 for each 1,000 gallons. John asked what Ron would raise it to and Ron declined to give an answer to that question. A.J. Call suggested we put in a water fill station in for surplus water and have it metered and do not allow hydrant use. A.J. said that the rates were raised 1 ½ years ago and thought that we matched Delta's price at that time. Discussion held. Topic tabled.

Rod has sprayed for mosquitos and Julie asked if it mattered if you go fast or slow when spraying for mosquitos.

Old Business

Tanya said that Income Survey will start mid to end of July.

Tanya said that Nature Works grant application was filed on time for the basketball/pickle ball court. It was more money than she expected it to be, but we don't have to take the grant if we think it will be too much money. It has to be completed within 2 years. We may be able to do some of the work ourselves.

The Memorial Day Parade went well

Tanya said that Janice D'Amico from Ohio EPA is working on dual OEL's

Tanya gave a Shuman update – The CDBG funds will be used to clean up that property. M. Shuman signed papers, but still retains the property. The earliest that they would start would be Fall, 2019 or Spring, 2020.
