Vote- Indigent Defense for 2026-Mark motioned and seconded by Landon to approve the 2026 Indigent Defense, 5 in favor, 0 opposed


Vote- EMA Contract for 2026-Landon motioned and seconded by John to approve the 2026 EMA Contract, 5 in favor, 0 opposed.
