Brush Bins : (next to the recycling building-on Eagle Street) to put brush and grass clippings in. Please fill the bins from **back to front**.

Brush/Branch Pick-Up-Maintenance crew will pick up "light trimmings." (April 1st through October 31st) Branches are to be no bigger than **4-inch diameter and 6-foot long**. The Village will not pick up large stumps, larger branches than what is stated above, or whole trees. (DO NOT PUT WHOLE TREES IN BRUSH BINS)

Sewer- No items other than human waste and toilet paper should be put into the sewer system. Flushable wipes should **never** be flushed into the sewer system. These **DO NOT** dissolve and cause issues with the system. Please do **NOT** put GREASE down your sink drains. Grease clogs the lift stations which will plug sewer lines going into residential/business properties. When this occurs basements will flood. If evidence is found that other items (appropriate items listed above) are in the sewer line, the owner of the property will be billed for the time and materials needed for the repair. Please keep all grass clippings/and leaves off the road ways so they do not plug up the sewer drains.

Zoning Notes- Please keep your property clean from trash, overgrown weeds, unwanted junk and pet waste. **All Vehicles are required to have a valid license plate** or needs to be stored in a closed area. Permit are required for new construction , fences, additions, barns etc.. If you are starting a new project and are unsure about permits please call the Village Office (419-923-2001).

Lyons Recycling Center-The recycling center is open on Saturday from 9a.m.-noon. The recycling center is located on Eagle Street. **Accepted**- tin, aluminum, milk jugs, egg cartons, cardboard, magazines, and newspapers. Please break down your cardboard before you put it on the trailer. The cardboard trailer is available every day.



Effective March 1st, 2026, we will implement a water rate increase. This change is necessary to align our rates with the current cost of operations, which has been impacted by significant price increases for essential water treatment products, maintenance parts and logistics, The last water rate adjustment was 2024. Our current 25-year water contract expires soon, and we will have a significant increase in wholesale costs at that time. Consequently, residents should expect additional incremental adjustments over the next few years to ensure continued water system integrity. **The base rate currently is \$23.65 in the Village & \$33.55 out of the Village. New rates will be in town \$29.56 & outside the Village \$41.94. Sewer rates remain the same.** Thank you for your understanding.
