COUNCIL MEETING

July 13, 2020 7:00 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Lyons Village Council called to order on Monday, July 13, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. Present: Council members A.J. Call, Nelson Barnhiser, John Good, Julie Fenicle, Jimmy Thornton and Mark Bryson; Village Administrator, Tanya Lumbrezer, and employee, Ron Ankney. The meeting opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion made by Julie Fenicle and seconded by John Good to accept the minutes from the June, 2020 meeting. 6 yea, motion passed.

A motion made by John Good and seconded by Jimmy Thornton to accept the Financial Reports from June, 2020 meeting. 6 yea, motion passed.

A motion made by Jimmy Thornton and seconded by Mark Bryson to accept the Bills from June, 2020 meeting. 6 yea, motion passed.

Employee's Report

*Ron reported that the June 2020 water usage was 2,900,000 gal., 96,000 gal. avg./day, and 118,000 gal. max./ day.

*Ron – Asbestos test – result not detected. Water is non corrosive/good on lead. Tower working great.

Committee Reports

*Trees – Call Jason again (Tree King). One by John Good is bad.

Old Business

*Joe Varner of Defiance, OH won the bid for the 2008 Chevy Truck for \$5,161. There were 6 bids total.
* A.J. – water loss balance, hopefully equals out – May usage – leak on County Road 10-2/MN, 25% with loss of 30,000 gal.

*Rory Figley's bill is the highest. Nelson asked if his taxes can be accessed this fall.

*Nelson – new sewer rates and water rates – will discuss

*RJ – meeting with FCEDC

*Tanya – CT Consultants

*New companies to county (Fayette and Delta), solar and metal. Letter from Matt Gilroy.

*Tax abatements – Matt Gilroy to go to school board meeting with Tanya. Tanya to contact Clay Cameron and Aaron Call. Abatement for homeowners and businesses – Council interested in that – Yes, set up with Matt Gilroy

*Ron and A.J. – water tower – THM smaller, fire dept. bigger. Andrea questioned can we have have a smaller one? Lower cost.? Discussion

*Recycle center – Tanya will call and see if they can bring at least the cardboard trailer back.

*Cameras – recycle area and parks and bins for grass and trees

*Natureworks grant can be used through 2021.

*CT Consultants ..Tanya has zoom meeting on July 16th to discuss water tower and basketball/pickleball court

*Shuman's asbestos inspection – June 8th ..We are in top 3 to be done first.

New Business

- *New tap on County Road L..Michael Ware. Because well was condemned from Health Dept. A.J. Call made a motion to approve, Nelson Barnhiser second the motion. 6 yea, motion passed.
- *A.J. asked Ron about water taps vs/new and not selling bulk water. Avg. house is min. 2,000 gal./month. Ron – save tap for in town and emergency outside
- *SB310 grant with Senator Gaverone – website is down. Trying for money for towns and villages.


Administrator's Report

- *Tanya gave an update on Sawmill and Kennedy Streets. Waiting on bid work from Fulton County Engineer's office.
- *Dave Pate's estimate for waterline to new house was \$30,000. He declined.
- *No regular chicken BBQ this year, pick-up chicken only on July 25th, no seating, 700 halves, same price
- *Tanya – subpoena – mail – divorce – water tap. Bills go back to 2007, no other information
- *Tanya – new billing system for water adjustment on a few bills. New reader works great.
- |*Tanya – State Auditor picked up boxes 7/9/2020 for 2018/2019 audit.
- *Tanya – EPA says water shut offs now can be enforced. We had 16, 10-day notices, 6, 1-day notice and 2 possible shut offs
- *Tanya – delivering final info. To Board of Elections pertaining to the levy.
- *Tanya – Fall letter to include: October 3 cleanup, emails for water, bills – to go paperless. Eventually, hopefully add payments online
- *Next meeting will be August 3rd

Mayor's Report

- *Debbie Crowell – complaint – semis at elevator. Tanya did call The Andersons. No permission – letter on trucks to not park there from The Andersons.
- *John Good – street – Wolf It Down, starting to heave. Probe or device for sonar?
- *Catch basins – still have not heard from Mikas
- *Sheriff's report was 30 hours for May with 10 complaints and 1 citation.
