The regular meeting of the Lyons Village Council called to order on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. Present: Council members A.J. Employee's Report

*The wiring for snowplow on the new truck is still not done. It has been gone at least 4 weeks since we've had the truck. If it is not fixed within the next week they will look into getting a new plow.

*August 2020 water usage was 3,266,000 gals. Avg. 105,400. Total of 130,000 gal. max/day.

*THM's Tower = 33.4 avg 37.1 Pump house = 51.9 avg 53.6

*The Village needs a new oxygen meter. Approx \$1,425, new probes range from \$350-450
