Brush Bins-The brush bins are next to the recycling building on Eagle Street and are for brush and grass clippings. Fill the bins from **back to front**.

Brush/Branch Pick Up-Maintenance crew will pick up "light trimmings." Starting April 1st through October 31st. Branches are to be no bigger than **4-inch diameter and 6-foot long**. The Village will not pick up large stumps, larger branches than what is stated above, or whole trees. (cut by homeowner or contractor).

Village Income Tax- The Village operates on a 1% income tax that applies to anyone 18 and older that lives or works within the village. It is on earned income only and does not apply to SS or retirement. For taxpayer assistance, contact RITA'S customer service department at 1-800-860-7482 Ext 5002.

Sewers- No items other than human waste and toilet paper should be put into the sewer system. Flushable wipes should **never** be flushed into the sewer system. These **DO NOT** dissolve and cause issues with the system. Do **NOT** put GREASE down your sink drains. Grease clogs the lift stations which will plug sewer lines going into residential/business properties. When this occurs basements will flood. If evidence is found that other items (appropriate items listed above) are in the sewer line, the owner of the property will be billed for the time and materials needed for the repair.

Atlas Disposal- Garbage tags are available at The Village Hall, Main Stop and Village Mart. If you are interested in having a tote instead of using tags, please call Atlas directly at 419-826-6655.

Zoning Notes- Keep your property clean from trash, weeds, unwanted junk and pet waste. **All Vehicles are required to have a valid license plate** or needs to be stored in a closed area. Permits are required for new construction, fences, additions, barns etc.. If you are starting a new project and are unsure about permits please call the Village Office (419-923-2001). Please keep all grass clippings/and leaves off the road ways so they do not plug up the sewer drains.

Lyons Recycling Center-The recycling center is open on Saturday from 9a.m.-noon. The recycling center is located on Eagle Street. **Things accepted**- tin, aluminum, milk jugs, egg cartons, cardboard, magazines, and newspapers. Please break down your cardboard before you put it on the trailer. The cardboard trailer is available every day. **Do not leave trash** or items outside the building.

Homeowners and DIYers- call before you dig, it's the law!!! If you plan to dig, call the Ohio Utilities Protection Service= OUPS call # **811 It's a Free Service**. If a water/gas/sewer etc. line is damaged, the homeowner will be charged for any repairs/damages.

Military/Veteran Forms are attached for any military/veteran person to fill out. This information will be kept confidential and only used to inform you of any helpful upcoming veteran/military events.

Unlimited Bulk Pick Up- Spring Unlimited Pick Up is **April 19th** door to door pick up.

Open Burning is prohibited. However, small pits in a rear yard with a screened lid for food consumption are allowed. Please call the Village Office at 419-923-2001 with any questions or visit Forestry.ohiodnr.gov/burning laws or epa.ohio.gov/dapc/general/openburning.

Mobile Alert System- If you have not sent in or filled out an information form for the **Mobile Alert System- CivicReady** - you can go to the County website www.fultoncountyoh.com to fill it out and receive important notices and upcoming events. The form is attached & can be filled out and dropped off (or mailed back) to/at the Village Office. **This information is kept private and will not be shared.**

Water & Sewer bill payments- A secure lock box is located to the right of the Village Office door for 24/7 payment access. If you are a State Bank customer, we encourage you to have your bill automatically deducted monthly with no cost to you. (Please call the Village Office if you are interested in this option). Also, there is an online payment option. You can access it through the Village of Lyons, Ohio website under **Paystar**.

Creating this account will allow you to keep track of your balance, sign up for reoccurring payments or pay monthly payments. Paystar does collect a small fee when you make your payments online.

ATLAS BULK PICK-UP GUIDELINES

SATURDAY, APRIL 19, 2025

HAVE ALL THE ITEMS OUT BY 6 A.M.

RESIDENTIAL BAGGED TRASH IS NOT CONSIDERED BULK AND WILL NOT BE COLLECTED ON BULK PICK-UP.

Regular garbage pick-up will be as usual on Thursday, April 17, 2025.

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS: Furniture- televisions, mattresses, box springs, etc., these are examples of acceptable items. All appliances must be certified "freon free".

NOT ACCEPTABLE: Leaves, tires, batteries, hazardous waste, oils, fuels, gas tanks, liquid paints, thinners, pesticides, fertilizers, liquid wastes, car parts, concrete, brick, stone, dirt, sod, blacktop, construction items, or demolition materials.

*******UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS WILL BE LEFT AT THE ROADSIDE*******

Please put items that are acceptable for bulk pick up, where you normally put your weekly trash pick-up.
